## VIBRANT PITTSBURGH AND THE URBAN AFFAIRS FOUNDATION OF THE JEWISH FEDERATION OF GREATER PITTSBURGH NOW ACCEPTING 2017 MINI-GRANT APPLICATIONS

**PITTSBURGH, PA:** Vibrant Pittsburgh and the Urban Affairs Foundation (part of the Community Relations Council) of the Jewish Federation of Greater Pittsburgh, two local champions of diversity, have once again joined forces to implement this year's Mini Grants Initiative: 2017 Civic Inclusion & Engagement Fund – New Partnerships.

This fund will promote diverse communities in the Pittsburgh region. Each organization has committed \$25,000 to create a \$50,000 pool to fund projects that increase the civic engagement of diverse and immigrant communities.

Funding will be available to applicants selected through a competitive proposal process. Lead organizations must have 501(c)(3) non-profit status and maintain a physical presence in the in the Power of 32 Region (see <a href="www.powerof32.org">www.powerof32.org</a>). Organizations can partner with other non-profits, academic institutions, religious organizations, community groups, businesses and employee resource groups. The term of proposed projects should be one year. The grants will range between \$500 and \$7,500.

Proposed initiatives should do one or more of the following:

- Create opportunities for community engagement that result in a more inclusive, multi-cultural region where diverse communities are valued, respected, visible and heard;
- Engage members of diverse communities in efforts that benefit their own community and/or the community at large;
- Reach out to the community at large to grow the awareness and engagement with diverse communities; and/or
- Be collaborative in nature by engaging diverse communities, organizations (non-profit, business or academic) and/or other community partners.

Grant **applications are due by 5 p.m. (EDT) on Thursday, August 31, 2017**. Successful applicants will receive funding by the end of November 2017.
